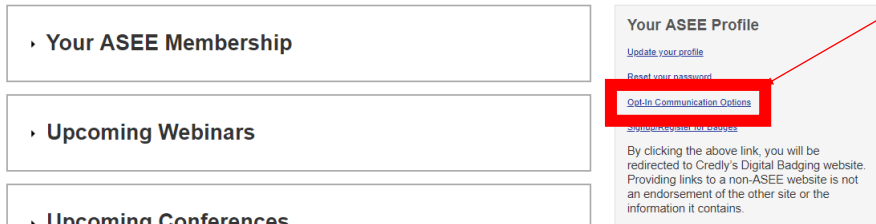

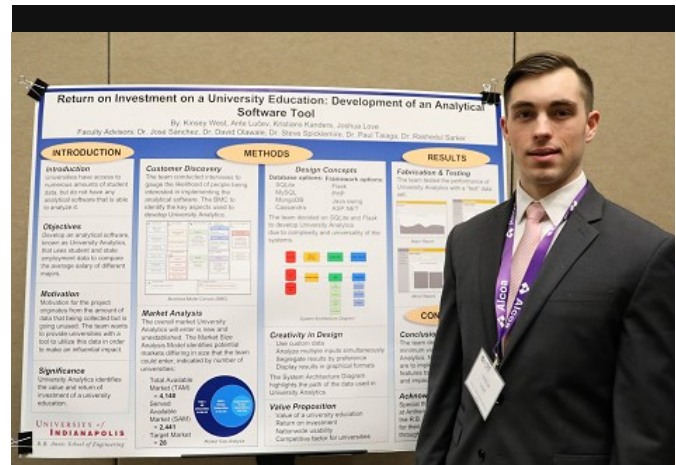
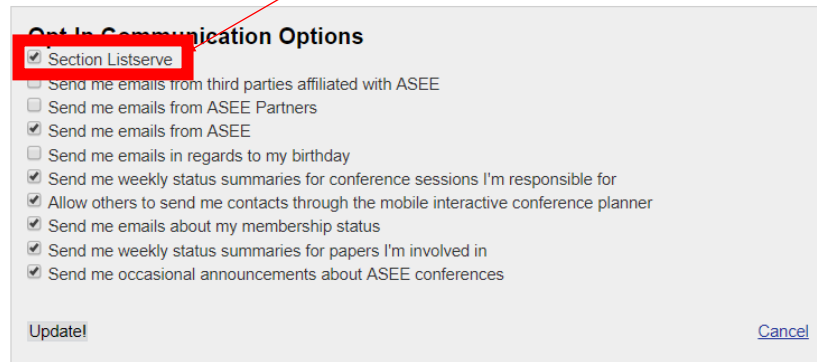
1. Log into your ASEE account at asee.org.

ASEE National Finances Improve

As many of you know, ASEE has been working tirelessly to shore up its finances for the last several years. ASEE has reduced operating expenses at headquarters and increased some fees. Because of these effects, ASEE is now in good financial health. Doug Tougaw, ASEE Vice President Finance and IL/IN section member, presented the financial health of ASEE at the Annual Conference. Two of the highlights from this presentation were

1. For the last four years ASEE has been able to add to net assets.
2. After several years of decreases in individual memberships, individual memberships in ASEE increased from 2018 to 2019. While the increase was small, the organization sees this as a positive sign that people are again seeing the value in ASEE membership.
